5. When Naomi decided to return to Bethlehem, what did Ruth decide to do? (1:16)

Ruth decided to go with Naomi.

6. What job did Ruth take to help provide for herself and Naomi? (2:2–7)

Gleaning - Picking up bits of barley left behind by the harvesters in the field

7. Who was impressed by Ruth's faithfulness to Naomi? (2:5–12)

Boaz

8. What did he do to help her? (2:14-16)

Gave her food & drink; told his men to be kind to her & purposely leaves stalks for her to pick up.

9. Boaz had the right to buy back Naomi's son's property to keep it in the family, provided he married the son's widow (Ruth). What was the word for a relative with this kind of privilege? (3:9)

10. What famous king of Israel was one of Ruth's great-grandsons? (4:17)

11. Who else came from Ruth's family tree? (See Matthew 1:5, 16)
