1. Many of the books of the Bible are named either for the person who wrote the book, or the person that the book is about. Write some names from the Bible that you know.

**Matthew, Mark, Luke, John, 1 & 2 Timothy, Titus, Esther, Daniel, Jonah, etc.**

2. The name of this book means "beginning."

**Genesis**

3. This book is about an "exit."

**Exodus**

4. This book is named for leaders who made important decisions.

**Judges**

5. These two books of the Bible are named after the women whose stories they tell. \_\_\_\_\_

**Esther & Ruth**

6. There are three books of songs in the Bible.

The name of this book means "songs or prayers": **Psalms**

This book is a collection of love songs written by a famous king: **Song of Solomon**

This book gets its name from the word "lament"—a song of sadness: **Lamentations**

7. These two books have similar-sounding names that both start with the letter Z.

**Zephaniah & Zechariah**

8. This New Testament book gets its name from "actions" that take place in the story.

**Acts**
